Apply twice daily for 4 days. After the treatment of 4 days, the skin will peel off over the next 4 days. You can carefully remove the peeling skin under lukewarm water. After the treatment, new skin (free from warts) will be formed. The wart may disappear as from the first week of treatment. If the wart does not disappear completely, repeat the treatment after a break of 4 days. You can repeat this treatment schedule up to 4 times.

EASY TO USE 4 STEP APPLICATION FOR WARTS & VERRUCAS







STEP 2 Allow the gel to lower into the tip for 3 to 5 seconds



STEP 3 Apply the cleared gel only on the wart or verruca (not on healthy skin surrounding it)



STEP 4

Let the gel dry for 10-15 minutes before putting on clothes or shoes. The formula is very concentrated and only one drop is needed per application. Carefully cover the entire surface of the wart and not the surrounding it.
